Rotational Analyst Program

The Rotational Analyst Program plays a pivotal role in how the Federal Home Loan Bank of Chicago develops and retains talent. Each rotational analyst follows a singular track engaging with four different teams over the course of two years, spending six months with each team. The goal for rotational analysts is to become well-rounded, while maintaining a long lasting network throughout the Bank!

- Cross-functional, six-month rotations that span a variety of business disciplines
- Opportunities to gain a deep understanding of how we support our members through our products, programs, services, and solutions
- Participation in meaningful projects that develop leadership and business acumen skills
- Unique volunteer activities, networking events, and business competitions that offer experiences with our members, executives, and community partners
- A mentor for each rotational analyst to leverage advice, support, and guidance
- Program alumni who volunteer their time and effort to ensure the program continues to act as an engine for future talent

Program Tracks

Business

Rotational analysts will gain exposure to four different business departments on both the Analytical and Operational sides of the Bank. A specific track will be based on an individual's background and what will provide them the most holistic view of FHLBank Chicago.

Throughout the program, rotational analysts will have the chance to:

- Support external stakeholders
- Execute member-facing projects and engagements

- Learn about the teams and systems that support our processes
- Understand the drivers of financial performance and risks to business lines. Rotational analysts may work in our Credit Risk, Member Transaction Desk, Financial Analysis, or other related departments during their track.

In addition, rotational analysts will gain understanding of the teams and systems behind the processes that support the Bank.

Finally, rotational analysts will gain an understanding and be able to articulate the drivers of financial performance and the risks to our business lines.

Information Technology (IT)

The IT track gives rotational analysts seeking a career in technology the opportunity to work in four different areas of IT: Service Desk, Security, Application Development, and IT Operations. Rotational analysts learn and participate in examining existing technical processes, supporting external and internal customers in developing technical solutions, and applying analytical and problem-solving skills to help identify, communicate, and resolve system issues.

Quantitative Rotational Program

This specialized track will develop our rotational analysts into quantitative leaders. They will receive mentorship from a member of our Executive Team, along with professional coaching to strengthen their leadership ability. This track is geared toward Master's level students with two years or less of experience in a quantitative-related role.
